YOUNG DRESSAGE RIDDEN CLASSES - 14th March

Class No	Entry Fee: <i>R 200-00 per horse</i>
1	4 year old Young Dressage horse under saddle – Prelim test Age determined: Must be 4 years old on or before 1 st June 2014
2	5 year old Young Dressage horse under saddle – Novice test Age determined: Must be 5 years old on or before 1 st June 2014
3	6 year old Young Eventer under saddle– Lower Elementary test Age determined: Must be 6 years old on or before 1 st June 2014

POTENTIAL EVENTERS - Ridden Classes- 15th March

Class No	Entry Fee: <i>R 200-00 per horse</i>
4	5 year old Young Eventer under saddle – Height of jumps 0.80 Age determined: Must be 5 years old on or before 1 st June 2014 - approx 15 obstacles and jumps
5	6 year old Young Eventer under saddle – Height of jumps 0.95 Age determined: Must be 6 years old on or before 1 st June 2014 - approx 17 obstacles and jumps
6	7 year old Young Eventer under saddle– Height of jumps 1.10 Age determined: Must be 7 years old on or before 1 st June 2014 - approx 18 obstacles and jumps

- Horse and rider will be required on entering the show jumping arena, to show the judges a small test of walk, trot, canter paces and a halt.
- Then jump a combined course under saddle of show jumps and eventing jumps which may include a combination; a small bank, dyke, water tray and other basic cross-country type fences.
- To end the course with an eventing type gallop into the main arena area.

To be judged on: Aptitude as an eventer including movement for dressage, attitude, scope, boldness, type, rideability, obedience, suitability for 3 day eventing.

LOOSE MOVEMENT-15th /16th March -Commentary will be live and scores publically announced.

Horses must have lunged before. There will be training opportunities in February and early March.

7	Potential Dressage Horse- 4 year old Age determined: Must be 4 years old on or before 30 th June 2014
8	Potential Dressage Horse - 3 year old Age determined: Must be 3 years old on or before 30 th June 2014

9	Potential Dressage Horse - 2 year old Age determined: Must be 2 years old on or before 30 th June 2014
10	Potential Dressage Horse-1 year old Age determined: Must be 1 years old on or before 1 st June 2014
11	Potential Dressage Horse – Weanling or foal (mares with foal at foot welcome) Age determined: Must be less than 1 year old on or before 1 st June 2011

FREE JUMPING-16th March - Commentary will be live and scores publically announced. Horses must have had some training before. **Jumping Line distances are: ground pole, 3m to cross, 6.8m to vertical, 7.1m to oxer.** There will be training opportunities in February and early March. 12	Free Jumping - 2 year old Age determined: Must be 2 years old on or before 30 th June 2014
13	Free Jumping - 3 year old Age determined: Must be 3 years old on or before 30 th June 2014
14	Free Jumping - 4 year old Age determined: Must be 4 years old on or before 30 th June 2014

Each horse is scored from 1 to 10 on five sections components:

Canter Stride- rhythm, balance, suppleness; **Approach and Attitude** Technique consisting of – courage, intelligence
Front action - tightness and quickness of the front legs; **Hindleg action** - activeness of the hind legs & use of the body over the jump; **Overall impression** – consisting of scope, athleticism and the horse’s ability, strength, carefulness -relating to his level of experience.
